SOCIAL STUDIES Weekly

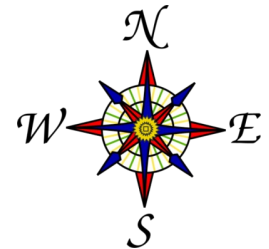
Dear Parents/Guardians,

Students will be using the Studies Weekly Magazine for Social Studies. This is a new format for core curriculum where the chapters of the textbook are published as weekly magazines. They teach the same information that textbooks do, but less intimidating like textbooks. To stay current, these publications are updated yearly. Studies Weekly publications are colorful with vivid illustrations. They have formal and informal assessments, crossword puzzles, writing assignments, biography spotlights, geography with colorful maps and charts, economic lessons, cultural spotlights, etc. There are online tools where students can listen to the text in rich character voices that hold their attention. The words light up on the screen as the text is read. They can watch primary source videos, listen to primary audio files, see primary source photos, etc. The magazines are updated each year and teach our current state social studies standards. The cost of each student subscription is \$8.50 which will cover the full curriculum of social studies for one full year and an additional on-line access to learn more.
