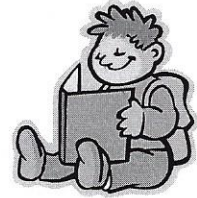
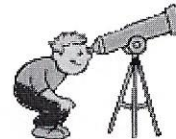



## Bent Tree Elementary Fourth & Fifth Grade Supply List 2024-2025



- 2- Packs of graph paper for Math
  - 2 - Packs of **wide ruled** loose notebook paper– **ON GOING THROUGH OUT THE YEAR.**
  - 8 - Composition notebooks, hard cover. Label as: *MATH, MULTIPLICATION CLUB, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES, WRITING, READING, GRAMMAR/HOMEWORK, and SPANISH.*
  - 36 - #2 **sharpened** pencils – **ON GOING THROUGH OUT THE YEAR**
  - 2 - White erasers
  - 1 **yellow plastic**, duo-tang folder with prongs for **4<sup>th</sup> grade** labeled **Reading.**
  - 1 **blue plastic**, duo-tang folder for **5<sup>th</sup> grade** labeled **Reading.**
  - 1 **red plastic**, duo-tang folder for **4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade** labeled **Reading.**
  - 1 **purple plastic**, duo-tang folder with pockets for **4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>** labeled **Science.**
  - 1 **orange plastic**, duo-tang folder with pockets for **4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>** labeled **Math.**
  - 6 red pens **ON GOING THROUGH OUT THE YEAR**
  - 8 blue pens **ON GOING THROUGH OUT THE YEAR**
  - 1 set of 24 **colored pencils** (**NO** crayons nor markers) for science
  - 1 set of 12 **colored pens** (**NO** markers) for science
  - 1 large pencil **pouch** (**NO** pencil boxes, they take too much space in desk)
  - 1 pack of multicolored highlighters, **yellow, orange, green, and blue** for **Reading/LA**
  - 1 pack of sticky notes for **Reading/LA**

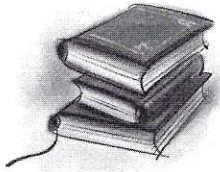

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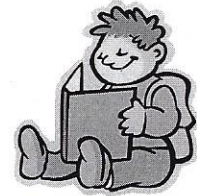
**Keep at Home:** Please keep a **separate set of common supplies at home** including an extra pair of headphones.
